PREFACE

The Town of Silverthorne, a home rule town, has published its Town Code in a format which features the following:

The *Table of Contents* is the table containing each chapter and article title, with reference to page location. Preceding each chapter is a chapter table of contents, also identifying each article by the subject name provided.

The *Disposition of Ordinances Table* identifies the source for the contents of the code. This table provides ordinance numbers in chronological order and location by section number for the present code contents. Thus, if there is interest in determining whether an ordinance, or a portion thereof, is contained within the code, the Disposition of Ordinances Table will provide that information. The *Table of Up-to-Date Pages* lists all of the current pages through the most recent supplementation.

The *Index* provides references by common and legal terminology to the appropriate code sections. Cross references are provided with the Index when appropriate.

Supplements to the code provide regular updating of the code to maintain it as a current compilation of all the legislation which has general and continuing effect. Without regular supplementation, the code would soon lose its usefulness as a complete source of the general law of the municipality. Supplementation is accomplished by the periodic publication of additions and amendments to the code.

**TOWN OF SILVERTHORNE, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 1995-1**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTHORNE, ADOPTING AND ENACTING A NEW MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE TOWN OF SILVERTHORNE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF AMENDING SUCH CODE; AND PROVIDING WHEN SUCH CODE AND THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTHORNE ORDAINS:

Section 1. The code entitled *Silverthorne Town Code* published by Colorado Code Publishing Company, consisting of Chapters 1 through 5, is adopted.

Section 2. All ordinances of a general and permanent nature enacted on or before this Ordinance, which are inconsistent with the provisions of the Silverthorne Town Code, to the extent of such inconsistency, are hereby repealed. All portions of the prior Code which are not made a part of the Silverthorne Town Code, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. The repeal established in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part thereof that had been previously repealed by any ordinance which is repealed by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The following codes were adopted by reference and incorporated in the Silverthorne Town Code. One (1) copy is on file in the Town Clerk's office:

(1) The *Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities*, 1977 edition, published by the State Department of Highways, 4201 Arkansas Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80222, as adopted and amended in Section 2-7-1 *et seq.*;

(2) The *National Electrical Code*, 1993 edition, published by the National Fire Protection Association, Batterymarch Park, Quincy, Massachusetts 02269, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-41 *et seq.*;

(3) The *Uniform Administrative Code*, 1993 edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-41 *et seq.*;

(4) The *Model Energy Code*, 1986 edition, published by the Council of American Building Officials, 1201 One Skyline Place, 5205 Leeburg Pike, Falls Church, Virginia 22041, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-61 *et seq.*; and

(5) The *Uniform Plumbing Code*, 1991 edition, published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, 20001 South Walnut Drive, Walnut, California 91789, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-141 *et seq.*

Section 5. The following codes are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated in the Silverthorne Town Code. One (1) copy is on file in the City Clerk's office:

(1) The *Uniform Building Code*, 1994 edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-1 *et seq.*;

(2) The *Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings*, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-21 *et seq.*;

(3) The *Uniform Fire Code* and *Uniform Fire Code Standards*, 1994 editions, as adopted by the Lake Dillon Fire Authority, as adopted in Section 4-3-81;

(4) The *Uniform Housing Code*, 1991 edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, as adopted in Section 4-3-101; and

(5) The *Uniform Mechanical Code*, 1994 edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601 and the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, 20001 South Walnut Drive, Walnut, California 91789, as adopted and amended in Section 4-3-21 *et seq.*

Section 6. The penalties provided by the Silverthorne Town Code are hereby adopted as follows:

(1) **Sec. 1-1-19. Violations and penalties. (Article I, General Provisions)**

Any person convicted in the Municipal Court of a violation of any section of this Code or ordinance of the Town may be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not to exceed one (1) year or fined an amount not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or ordered to participate in a useful public service program pursuant to the provisions of Section 1-3-10(b), or any combination of the above, except as is provided in Section 1-1-20. Each day upon which any violation shall continue shall constitute a separate misdemeanor unless some other specific time period is provided for any particular violation.

(2) **Sec. 1-10-21. Authority of the General Government Director. (Article X, Sales Tax)**

(9) Motor vehicle registrations. If the General Government Director determines that a person has registered or caused to be registered a motor vehicle outside the Town and that such motor vehicle should have been registered at an address in the Town, the General Government Director is authorized to assess a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) against the person. A written notice of the penalty assessment shall be issued, paid and protested in the same manner as a notice of assessment. The General Government Director may enforce collection of the penalty assessment in the same manner as provided in this Article for the collection of tax due. Assessment and collection of this penalty shall not preclude the collection of any tax due or fee on the imposition of any other civil or criminal penalty provided by law.

(3) **Sec. 1-10-44. Penalties. (Article X, Sales Tax)**

(a) Penalty for late payment of sales tax. A penalty of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) or ten percent (10%) of the tax deficiency, whichever is greater, shall be levied on any tax deficiency.

(b) Penalty for fraud. If any tax deficiency is due to fraud or the intent to evade the tax, the penalty shall be fifty percent (50%) of the total tax deficiency.

(c) Penalty for repeated enforcement. If three (3) notices of assessment have been issued to the same taxpayer within thirty-six (36) consecutive months, a special penalty of fifteen percent (15%) of the total tax liability, or twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), whichever is greater, shall be levied in addition to the penalties levied in Subsection (a) above.

(4) **Sec. 2-7-2. Additions and modifications. (Article VII, Vehicles and Traffic)**

"(d) (1) Traffic infractions as provided in this code shall be subject to the following penalties, which are authorized upon entry of judgment against the defendant:

"Minimum Penalty	Maximum Penalty
"Fine of \$5.00	Fine of \$200.00

"Court costs as authorized by state law [13-10-113(3) C.R.S., as amended] shall be added to the fine.

"(2) Misdemeanors and misdemeanor traffic offenses as provided in this code shall be subject to the following penalties, which are authorized upon conviction:

"Minimum Sentence	Maximum Sentence
1 day imprisonment or a fine of \$10.00, or both	1 year imprisonment or a fine of \$1,000.00, or both

"Court costs as authorized by state law [13-10-113(3) C.R.S., as amended] shall be added to the fine."

(5) **Sec. 3-5-7. Violations and penalties. (Article V, Overhead Utilities)**

Any person violating any provision of this Article shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. For each violation, the violator will be given a written citation on the violation and will have ten (10) days from the date of the postmark to correct the violation or arrive at a solution acceptable to the Town before the fine begins to accrue. Failure to remove or underground the violating poles, overhead wires and associated structures will result in removal or undergrounding by the Town at the sole expense of the person responsible for such failure. Such expense shall be a lien against any property in the State owned by such person and may be foreclosed as provided by law.

(6) **Sec. 4-4-64. Enforcement; violations and penalties. (Article IV, Land Use Review Process)**

(a) Any subdivider or agent of a subdivider who transfers, sells, agrees to sell or offers to sell any subdivided land, including land approved as a PUD but divided into separate parcels, before a final plat for such subdivided land has been approved by the Town and recorded or filed in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each parcel or interest in subdivided land which is sold or offered for sale.

Section 7. Additions or amendments to the Code, when adopted in the form as to indicate the intention of the Town to make the same a part of the Code, shall be deemed to be incorporated in the Code, so that reference to the Code includes the additions and amendments.

Section 8. Ordinances adopted after this Ordinance that amend or refer to ordinances that have been codified in the Code, shall be construed as if they amend or refer to those provisions of the Code.

Section 9. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after approval, as provided by the Charter.
