

FIRE DANGER!

Stage 2 Fire Restrictions

The White River National Forest has issued Stage 2 Fire Restrictions on all White River National Forest Lands beginning 8:00am on Friday, June 29.

You Can Help!

Follow these restrictions:

SHOOTING

PROHIBITED: Using an explosive including but not limited to blasting caps, rockets, exploding targets and tracers or incendiary ammunition. (The use of fireworks, flares or other incendiary devices is always prohibited on federal lands).

CAMPFIRES

PROHIBITED: Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire or campfire, charcoal grill, coal, wood burning stove or shepherders stove, including in developed camp and picnic grounds.

PERMITTED: Devices using pressurized liquid or gas that include shut-off valves are permitted when used in an area at least three feet or more from flammable material.



SMOKING

PROHIBITED: Smoking outdoors on National Forest System Lands.

PERMITTED: Smoking within an enclosed vehicle, trailer, or building.



OTHER RESTRICTIONS

PROHIBITED: Using a Chainsaw without an approved spark arrester and materials below.

PERMITTED: Using a chainsaw with approved spark arrester, chemical pressurized fire extinguisher, and a round pointed shovel at least 35 inches in length available for use.



PROHIBITED: Operating any internal combustion engine (ATV, generator) without a spark arresting device properly installed and in working order.



PROHIBITED: Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame.
PERMITTED: Welding with a current permit, contract or letter of authorization.



PROHIBITED: Operating a motor vehicle off National Forest System roads.
EXCEPT: When parking in an area devoid of vegetation within 10 feet of the roadway, or at trailheads and developed campgrounds
